Exodus 14 Crossing the Red Sea

The Lord instructs Moses for the people to camp in front of the Red Sea. This leads Pharaoh to believe they are wandering and that they are lost. The Lord hardens the heart of Pharaoh in order that he will pursue the Hebrews. Then the Lord will have His glory over Pharaoh and his army of 600 chariots plus additional forces. This will happen that all will know the power of the Lord.

Pharaoh realizes he has let the people of Israel depart and he calls out his army to pursue and return the Hebrews to Egypt. When the people realized this, they cried out, We could have been buried in Egypt. Why are we out here in the wilderness. Let us go back to Egypt, be slaves, and live.

Moses replied, "Fear not.... The Lord will fight for you, and you only have only to be silent."
Read Revelation 19: 11-16

Moses then is commanded to lift his staff and order the people forward toward the sea. The sea parted and the people went forth on dry land.

Then the angel of the Lord who traveled before Israel moved and went behind them. The Hebrews were protected by the angel of the Lord. However, as the Egyptians followed, they were bogged down and collided, and the waters came over them. Not an Egyptian survived. The people saw the destruction of the Egyptians and feared the Lord. They believed in Him and in Moses.
