Exodus 34 Moses Makes New Tablets

Exodus 34: 1-9 Moses had requested God reveal His ways to him in Exodus 33: 12-23

God tells Moses to cut two more tablets and He will write on them. He is to come by himself and not even cattle or sheep or allowed on the mountain. The Lord passed by Moses and reaffirmed His love for Israel (Ex 34: 6-7). Moses requests that God Himself go with Israel to the Promised land, to forgive them, and to take them as His own.

Exodus 34: 10-27 The Covenant Renewed – No other gods allowed

Moses was with God 40 days and 40 nights, having nothing to eat or drink. God wrote the on the tablets, the words of the covenant, the Ten Commandments.

Exodus 34: 29-35 The Shining Face of Moses

When Moses came down from the mountain with the tablets, the people were afraid to look at him due to his shining face. This was a sign that it was God who was speaking to Moses. He had to wear a veil when he was in the midst of the people.

Read 2 Corinthians 3: 1-18 Ministers of the New Covenant – Ministry of the Spirit

God promised a new day with new hearts and new beginnings. Read Jeremiah 31:33-34; Ezekiel 11:16-21.

The Law brings death but belief in Jesus brings life. Only by believing in Jesus can a person receive eternal life through the Holy Spirit. Forgiveness only comes through the grace and mercy of Christ. Read Romans 8:1-11; 8: 37-39
